CONFIRMATION CLASSES

Confirmation classes will begin in September 2021. Attendance and participation is mandatory. Students are allowed one unexcused absence and one excused absence that is to be made-up with an assignment.

An absence is considered excused if you have notified the RE Office or your instructor before class begins and your absence is due to illness.

SERVICE HOURS

Students must complete 15 hours of service in Year 1 and in Year 2. There are many opportunities available through our parish as well as the community. Students may participate in the Teen Mass each Sunday for service hours, or in one of the many parish ministries.

Participation in the Teen Mass includes: Readers, Altar Servers, Choir, and Ushers. If you choose to participate in one of these ministries, you are expected to commit to the training and/or practices, as well as the schedule they implement.

Religious Education welcomes volunteers to assist in the classrooms each week.

LETTER OF INTENT

Candidates in Year 2 are required to write a letter to Msgr. McCormick giving their reasons for wanting to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. The letter introduces the candidate to Msgr. McCormick, therefore it should give your personal feelings concerning the sacrament, the Church, and your faith life. The letter can include how you have prepared, your sponsor choice, and why and how you plan to share your gifts with the Church, family and community. Your letter should be no longer than 2 paragraphs.

SPONSOR

Sponsors for Confirmation must be fully initiated into the Catholic Church via the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation. If married, living in a sacramental marriage. The selection of sponsor is to be based on appropriate lifestyle, participation in the Catholic Church, and the ability to provide the nurturing, supportive role of a sponsor.

If possible, choose one of the baptismal sponsors (godparents) to serve as the confirmation sponsor, so as to emphasize the relationship between baptism and confirmation. (Canon 893, #2).

Sponsor forms should be completed and submitted by the beginning of Year 2. Forms are available on the website.

MASS

Weekly Mass attendance is required. You have the option to attend Mass in person or watch the Live Stream of the 10 am Mass using the link on the Holy Spirit Website. Please check the website and the bulletin to keep informed of any updates.

RETREATS

Students in the Confirmation program are required to attend one retreat. More information will be provided once the program begins.

SAINT NAME

Each candidate is required to choose a Saint Name. Teens are encouraged to prayerfully consider the lives of the Saints and choose one who inspires them or has special meaning to them to accompany them in their life of faith. Your Saint Name is to be submitted to the Religious Education Office.

SAINT PROJECT

Year 2 Confirmation Candidates must complete a Saint Project on his/her Saint. This project can be done in any format, as long as students present their Saint clearly. Examples include, but are not limited to: a written report, drawing, painting, poem, song, art piece, video, power point, etc. Be creative. Due 2 weeks prior to Confirmation.
